RESTRICTION OF MASTERS EVENTS

Masters athletes shall only compete in their own age group in individual events and only one age category in team events (all as set out in the SLSA Policy 5.4). In boat events the sweep does not have to be of Masters Age. The age category applies only to the four rowers.

For any event to be contested a minimum of four (4) starters are required. Where there is less than the minimum of starters athletes may contest a lower age group of the same event without prejudice to his/her age category in other events.

CHAMPIONSHIPS POINTSCORE

The following pointscores will be kept and awarded at the conclusion of the championships;

- Highest overall pointscore
- Highest overall Country Club pointscore
- Highest overall pointscore in U15 age group
- Highest overall pointscore in U17 age group
- Highest overall pointscore in U19 age group
- Highest overall pointscore in Open age group

RESULTS

In the case of a dead heat for positions 1st, 2nd or 3rd each competitor will receive a respective medal. In the case of a dead heat for 1st place, both winning competitors will receive a gold medal and the 3rd place competitor will receive a bronze medal – No Silver medal will be awarded. No Bronze medals will be awarded for a dead heat in 2nd place.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

As a condition of entry, all competitors agree to have any photography taken during the championships used for promotional material by SLSNSW.

MEMBERSHIP

All competitors entered into these 2010 Allphones Surf Life Saving Championships must be financial, proficient members of the club for which they are entered.

There will be a number of clubs randomly selected from across the State to be part of an audit of Proficiency and Patrol Hours. These clubs will be notified by 9 February.

Clubs will be audited on the following three items/requirements:

1) Log Book 2) Entry into Surfguard 3) Hours supplied in the Service Agreement.

All Clubs entering the 2010 NSW Allphones Masters & Open Surf Life Saving Championships must have service agreements signed and returned to SLSNSW and have Surfguard log books up to date.

WATER SAFETY AND POWERCRAFT REQUIREMENTS

Clubs with 50 competitors plus are required to supply one fully equipped IRB with crew for use during the Championships.

Powercraft are crucial to the safe operation of the Championships so please ensure that these requirements are met.

SCRUTINEERING

All craft and equipment being used at the 2010 NSW Surf Life Saving Championships will be required to carry a valid Red and White Scrutineering Sticker. Random scrutineering of craft and equipment will take place throughout the duration of the carnival. Finalists may be required to have their craft scrutineered prior to racing in event finals. Scrutineering will be available for all members at a cost of \$110.00 (incl. GST).

CARNIVAL OFFICIALS

An officials quota system for clubs to provide Accredited Officials based upon the number of competitors entered is in place for the Masters Championships only.

March Past and R&R teams are not excluded from this quota system. Late entries will be added to the total number of competitors entered to ensure that the club's obligation is satisfied.

The following schedule sets out the quota requirements for clubs to submit their nominations of Officials for these Championships, who, as a minimum requirement, must have a current accreditation license number.

Cheques are to be made payable to "**Surf Life Saving New South Wales**" and forwarded along with the invoice & Declaration Form to reach SLSNSW by Wednesday, February 17, 2010 or a late fee will be charged. Entry fees are not refundable if members do not take part in these Championships.

LATE ENTRIES

Clubs will be able to submit Late Entries for the Championships using the registration website, one week after the close of entries. Late Entries may be submitted online between 12:01am Tuesday, February 2, 2010 to 11:59pm Sunday, February 7, 2010. All Late Entries after this date will need to be entered onsite at the Carnival Administration Centre on the southern side of Swansea Belmont SLSC. These need to be accompanied by the athletes DOB, Proficiency Date, Patrol hours details and appropriate fees. All entries received after the closing will incur a Late Fee of \$53.00 plus the original entry fee of \$32.00 (\$53.00 + \$32.00 = \$85.00 inc. GST).

Additional Events

When additional events are required for competitors or teams already entered, an administration fee of **\$16.00** [incl. GST] **per event per competitor** will be charged. Additional event entries must be received no later than one hour before the start of the particular event.

NOTE: All late entries and additional events received onsite (Swansea Belmont SLSC) will need to be accompanied by payment, the athlete's DOB, Proficiency Date, Patrol hours details and appropriate fees.
