## RESTRICTION OF EVENTS

- **2 Person R&R** – Unlimited entries (U10, U11, U12, U13)
- **5 Person R&R** – Unlimited entries (U12, U13, U14)
- **Surf Teams** – 5 male/ 5 Female teams per club per age group (U9 to U14 years)
- **Beach Relays** – 5 Male teams and 5 Female teams per club per age group (U8 to U14 years)
- **Wade Relay** – 5 Male / 5 Female teams per club (U8 years)
- **Cameron Relay** – Open Gender - 2 teams per metropolitan club & 1 team per country club
- **Board Rescue** - 3 Male teams and 3 Female teams per club per age group (U11 to U14 years)
- **Surf Board Relay** - 5 Male teams and 5 Female teams per club per age group (U9 to U14 years)
- **All Age Board relay** – 2 teams per metro branch & 1 team per country branch (U9 to U14 years – any gender combination)
- **All Age Beach Relay** - 1 team per club (U8 to U14 – any gender combination)

**NB/** No favoured consideration will be given to competitors who attempt to compete in more than one [1] area. [I.e. Events will not be delayed for this reason].

## CHAMPIONSHIPS POINTSCORE

A pointscore will be kept for the highest overall pointscore and highest overall country club pointscore.

## RESULTS

In the case of a dead heat for positions 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> each competitor will receive a respective medal. In the case of a dead heat for 1<sup>st</sup> place, both winning competitors will receive a gold medal and the 3<sup>rd</sup> place competitor will receive a bronze medal – No Silver medal will be awarded. No Bronze medals will be awarded for a dead heat in 2<sup>nd</sup> place.

## ENTRY CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

As a condition of entry, all competitors agree to have any photography taken during the championships used for promotional material by SLSNSW.

## PROFICIENCIES

Prior to competing at the 2010 Age Surf Life Saving Championships, U14 competitors must have completed their SRC or SRC proficiency test before the closing date for club entries.

Entry details for all competitors must be submitted by way of the electronic Registration Program.

## CARNIVAL OFFICIALS

An officials quota system for clubs to provide Accredited Officials based upon the number of competitors entered is in place for the Age Championships. March Past and R&R teams are not excluded from this quota system. Late entries will be added to the total number of competitors entered to ensure that the club's obligation is satisfied.

The following schedule sets out the quota requirements for clubs. Officials as a minimum requirement must have a current accreditation license number.

9 – 19 Competitors	1 Official
20 – 39 Competitors	2 Officials
40 – 59 Competitors	3 Officials
60 – 79 Competitors	4 Officials
80 – 99 Competitors	5 Officials
100 + Competitors	6 Officials

**If sufficient officials are not provided according to the above quotas a \$500.00 fee will be charged for each official under the quota.**

All Clubs entering the 2010 Age Surf Life Saving Championships must have service agreements signed and returned to SLSNSW and have Surfguard log books up to date.

### **WATER SAFETY AND POWERCRAFT REQUIREMENTS**

Clubs with 50 competitors plus are required to supply one fully equipped IRB with crew for use during the Championships.

The following quota will apply for water safety during the Age Championships:

30 – 69 competitors = 3 water safety personnel

70 – 109 competitors = 4 water safety personnel

110 competitors plus = 5 water safety.

A water safety and powercraft nomination form can be found on the Surf Life Saving NSW website.

Water safety and powercraft are crucial to the safe operation of the Championships so please ensure you follow these requirements.

### **ENTRY REGISTRATIONS**

Club entries to the 2010 Age Surf Life Saving Championships must be submitted electronically **DIRECTLY** into the entry registration web site program:

The web site 'Entry Page' must be completed in detail as directed by the instructions set out on the cover page of the registration program.

Entries close Monday, February 1, 2010 at midnight EDST

### **ENTRY FEES**

A club's total entry fee for the 2010 NSW Age Surf Life Saving Championships will be established by the number of competitors listed on the entry form multiplied by the appropriate fee. (The amounts listed below are GST inclusive).

Cheques are to be made payable to "**Surf Life Saving New South Wales**" and forwarded along with the invoice to reach SLSNSW by Friday, February 5, 2010.

**Entry fees are not refundable if members do not take part in these Championships.**

### **LATE ENTRIES**

Clubs will be able to submit Late Entries for the Championships using the registration website for one week after the close of entries.

Late Entries may be submitted online between 12:01am on Tuesday, February 2, 2010 and 11:59pm on Sunday, February 7, 2010.

All entries received after the closing will incur a Late Fee of \$53.00 plus the Original entry of \$22.00 [i.e. (\$53.00 + \$22.00 = \$75.00) incl. GST].

All Late Entries after this date will need to be entered onsite at the Carnival Administration Centre on the southern side of Swansea Belmont SLSC.

### **Additional Events**

When additional events are required for competitors or teams already entered, an administration fee of \$16.00 [incl. GST] per event per competitor will be charged. Additional event entries must be received no later than one hour before the start of the particular event.

### **NOTE:**

All late entries and additional events received at the event site (Swansea Belmont SLSC) will need to be accompanied by payment, the athletes DOB, Proficiency Date and appropriate fees.
